2021 Clos Bagatelle, Cuvée à l'origine, Saint Chinian Languedoc

2021 Domaine des Bonnetières, Beaujolais

100% Gamay. This Beaujolais is complex and bright with a combination of red berries, floral and spiced notes. The body is fleshy with a nice tannic spine that bring the wine further. Bottle \$80

2022 Domaine de l'Arjolle, Syrah Equilibre, Côtes de Thongues

100% Syrah. Warm and inviting red colour. The nose is an explosion of dark ripe fruits. In the mouth, a sensation of fruit coulis showcases its young character which makes it round and silky on the palate. Bottle \$80

2021 Chateau Gantonnet, Entre-deux-mers, Bordeaux

2021 Domaine Françoise et Denis Clair, AOC Haute Côte de Beaune

100% Pinot Noir. Beautiful nose of red fruits, very lifted and fine. In the mouth, the wine is intense and the tannin are softs. Crunchy wine, easy to drink but elegant with a great length. Bottle \$170

2021 Domaine Darnaud, Les Trois Chênes, Crozes Hermitage

100% Syrah. The palate is supple and powerful. Notes of smoke, black pepper and clove bring a spicy touch to the wine while notes of pencil lead bring freshness to the finish. The tannins are dense and velvety. Nice length in the mouth.

2021 Domaine Gradassi, Châteauneuf-du-Pape

Grenache and Mourvedre. Maturation of 10 months in old oak barrels. The wine is completely dry and savory, with high tones that balance their full bodied structure. 2019 Domaine Truchetet, Les Topons, Nuits-Saint-Georges

100% Pinot Noir. Deeply scented with ripe dark plums, sandalwood spice, savoury notes, a hint of wild meatiness and a juicy persistence! Super stylish, maybe even pretty for a Nuits, but that touch of wild gives a nod to its terroir. Bottle \$270
